

Greenhead House Farm. Tramlines camping 20 - 23 July

General information and site rules

NB. Camping/motorhome tickets do not include admission to Tramlines or transport to and from the event.

General information

Greenhead House Farm is a family run small holding. We are opening a field for a temporary campsite for the weekend of Tramlines. All facilities will be temporary.

The site will be open from 10am Friday 20 July to 11am Monday 23 July. Tickets are purchased per person per night.

Guests are asked to be considerate at all times, particularly late at night, to our neighbours and local residents. It is a working farm we keep a number of animals. Dogs are not permitted.

There will be no bar or entertainment and guests are requested not to play loud music at any time of day or night.

On arrival

Using satnav, the postcode S35 0HN, will take you about 300yds too far down the hill. Head back up Oughtibridge Lane. The camping field will be signposted and have bunting around the entrance.

Toilets/washing facilities

There will be a number of portaloos and a shower unit on site. Hand washing and drinking water will also be available.

Oughtibridge

Oughtibridge is about a ½ mile walk down the hill. There are 4 pubs, an Italian restaurant, a Chinese takeaway and 3 convenience shops. Public transport from Oughtibridge will take you to Hillsborough, Sheffield City Centre and Meadowhall.

Animals

We keep pigs, goats and hens on the farm. Please do not feed them unless with a member of staff. There are electric fences on site that are clearly labelled

Site Rules

Please take time to read though the following points. It is a small family-run working smallholding. Do not hesitate to ask if you need more information.

- Be careful, considerate and thoughtful to others and leave the site just as you found it.
- All litter and rubbish is the responsibility of the individual campers, please use the bins provided
- A strict 5 mph speed limit operates on site at all times.
- Care should be taken when leaving the site by car onto Oughtibridge Lane. Exiting left is a safer option to avoid crossing traffic travelling down the hill.
- Smoking is not permitted in or round the food serving area.
- Generators are not permitted.
- Dogs are not allowed.
- Torches will be useful for around site as the ground is uneven in places.
- Radio/television/music etc. must not be played to the annoyance of other campers. A good rule of thumb is, if it can be heard from the next pitch then it is too loud. Please think of others regarding noise and keep it to a minimum throughout the day and night.
- Please respect other campers' privacy.
- BBQ's are allowed but must be raised off the ground. Bricks will be available on request.
- BBQ's are the responsibility of the camper; remember the coals stay hot well after your food is cooked so please double check that they are completely extinguished after use.
- Please do not tip used oil or boiling water onto the grass and keep hot pans/kettles raised as these also scorch the grass.
- Open fires of any kind are strictly forbidden, as is the discharge of fireworks and Chinese lanterns on the campsite and surrounding areas.
- **FIREWORKS and CHINESE LANTERNS** are strictly forbidden. Pylons are close by.
- KITE flying is strictly forbidden.
- No vehicles or motorcycles of any kind are to be driven/ridden around the site for amusement.
- No excessive use of water i.e. washing of vehicles or paddling pools etc.
- General conduct: If in our opinion anyone staying onsite is considered to be of unreasonable behaviour, causing annoyance to either our interests, our neighbours or those of other campers, they will be asked to leave immediately.
- In the event of a fire or evacuation please meet at the marquee.
- Emergency First Aid point – please find a staff member who will direct you to the first aid point in Stable 1.
- Please respect the boundary walls, trees and fencing. No climbing or standing on the walls or trees. There are areas of barbed wire on the top line of fencing.

Hillsborough park is 3 miles away from the campsite. When travelling from Hillsborough to the Campsite, the first 2.5 miles are flat, the last ½ a mile is a steep hill without public transport. There is regular public transport from Oughtibridge to Hillsborough, but not from Oughtibridge to the campsite. The campsite is situated ½ a mile up a steep hill which was one of the climbs on the 2014 Tour de France.
